so His birth in us brings us joy.

God calls us to share the joy He gives with each other.

One: We light the candle of LOVE to remind us that Jesus is God's gift of love to us – and that in Him, the light of love triumphs over darkness.

Many: Love never fails – it transforms all those who give it and receive it.

God calls us to share his love with each other.

One: We light the Christ candle to remind us that the light of the world was born this night.

Many: The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. Those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness

– on them a light has shined.

Almighty God - you have made this night holy by the gift of your son, born of the Holy Spirit and of Mary. Upon Him rested all your grace, through him has come all your mercy.
