



Holy Spirit, ever working through the church's ministry


Quickening, strengthening, and exsolving, setting captive sinners free;

In you we live and move and have our being.


We open ourselves to your presence in this time of worship.

Time Especially for Children Let's sing "Jesus loves me" Come in close and bring your listening ears




