We have so much more to do. We take this opportunity to walk prayerfully, encircling the Meetinghouse with our prayers of thanksgiving. We walk, we pray, we give thanks. Learn about our history and walk alongside us into God's future.

Station #1: Sanctuary Rehabilitation

Exodus 15:17: "You brought them in and planted them on the mountain of your own possession, the place, O Lord, that you made your abode, the **sanctuary**, O Lord, that your hands have established."

O Lord, Many generations have gathered in the beautiful sanctuary inside our Meetinghouse. They have prayed and worshipped; we have baptized Your children, married folks in love and said goodbye to loved ones from this physical place. You have been present from one-story to two, from plain windows to stained glass, from decoratively painted ceilings to white tin. We feel at peace and in Your present when we enter in. Thank You, Lord, for the day when we will worship You again from inside this holy space. Amen.

Station #2: Accessibility Connector

Mark 10:9: "Therefore what God has **joined together**, let no one separate."

Gracious God, you were with the saints who built the Meetinghouse in 1769. You were with the saints who built the Noyes education building in 1973. Thank you for being with us in 2020 as we faithfully steward the connection between these two physical buildings – one for worship and connections, and one for education and connections. We honor you by making these buildings accessible to all of Your children on all levels. You connect us, God, to Yourself and to one another. We thank You for connections of all kinds. Amen.

Station #7: Foundation & Timber Frame

Exra 3:11: "and they sang responsively, praising and giving thanks to the Lord, "For he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever toward Israel." And all the people responded with a great shout when they praised the Lord, because the **foundation** of the house of the Lord was laid."

Gracious God, in these times of anguish and distress, we thank You for the great power of Your compassionate love. We thank You as well for entrusting us with a share in the work of Your Spirit to bind us together as a community of faith, to build us into Christ's body, a parish family, a caring people. Empower us to be good stewards of our time, talent and treasure so that we may build the City of God, the only secure dwelling in our world.

We walk now, circling this sacred place, in profound gratitude that You ordained the raising of this building and the building of the solid structural foundation.

Meetinghouse Prayer Circles




Praying Circles of Gratitude Around the Meetinghouse at First Parish Church over Seven Weeks
