

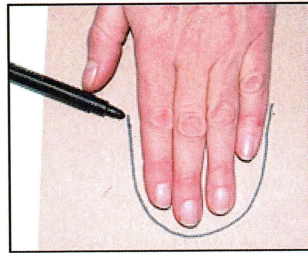
LION PUPPET TUTORIAL

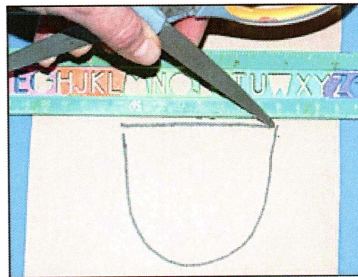


PUPPET MOUTH INSERT (INSERT INTO SOCK)

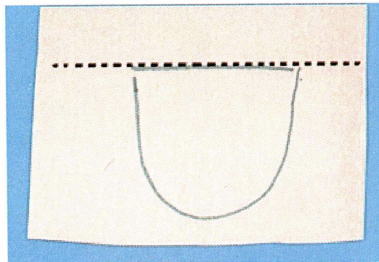
LION'S EARS (CUT THESE OUT AND USE THESE AS TEMPLATES TO CUT OUT FELT)



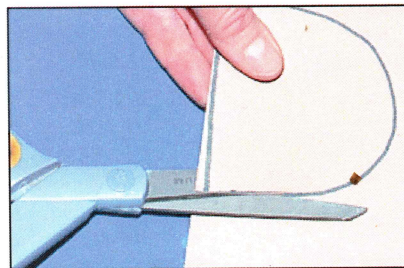
1. Trace around your four fingers to make the mouth shape at the top of a piece of cardboard. Draw a line across the bottom of the arch shape you drew.



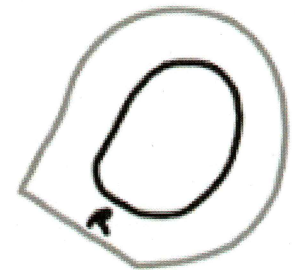
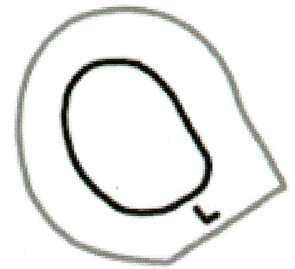
2. Score the cardboard with something sharp along the straight line so it folds easily.

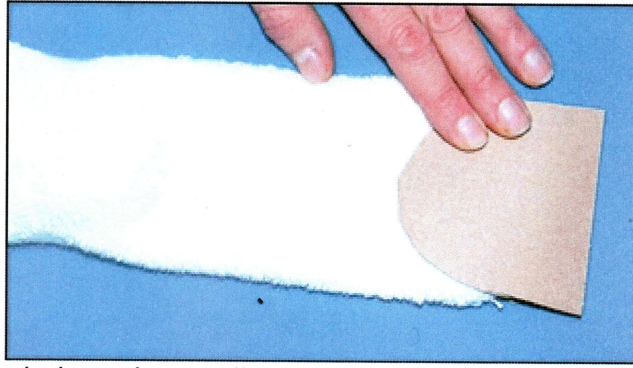


3. Fold the cardboard in half along the score line.



4. Cut out the mouth shape with the card-board folded in half.





5. Turn the sock inside out and place the cardboard mouth piece over the toe of the sock so that the toe of the sock is inside the mouth piece and touching the folded edge of the mouth piece.
6. Glue the mouth piece to the sock with Glue Dots provided or a low temperature glue gun (with parental supervision!)
7. Turn the sock right-side out.
8. Cut a inside mouth shape from red felt. Place it in the mouth to see if it fits. Trim it down if it doesn't fit all the way in the mouth. Glue the piece to the inside of the mouth.
9. Put your hand in the sock and draw with a marker the outline of where where you want the eyes and nose, then color in the eyes and nose and draw whiskers.
10. Cut out ear shapes from brown or yellow felt (your choice) and then cut the same shape from red felt only make them a little smaller. Glue the red smaller pieces to the ear pieces. Place some glue at the bottom of each ear and pinch to make a fold at the bottom of the ear. Stuff the sock with newspaper or a rag and then glue the ears to the sock.
12. Cut the color you chose for the Mane into small hair -like pieces on top being careful not to cut all the way through the felt and glue them around the top of the head, and glue ears onto neck of the puppet using glue dots or hot glue with parental supervision. Remove the rag.
