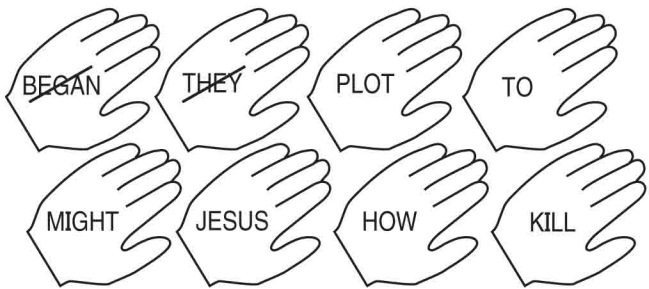




What did the Pharisees do next?

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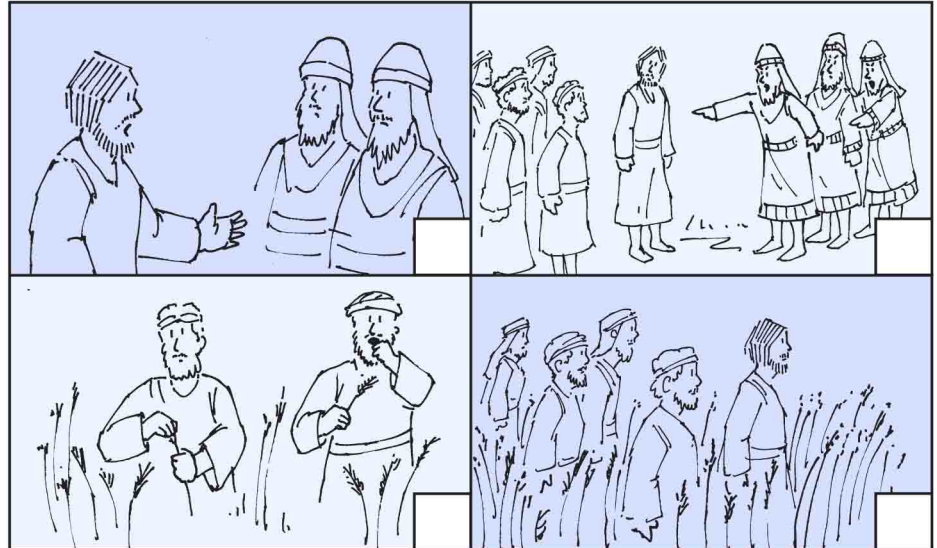

Lord of the Sabbath

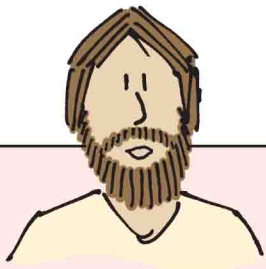
God had given the law to help people, not to be a burden to them.
