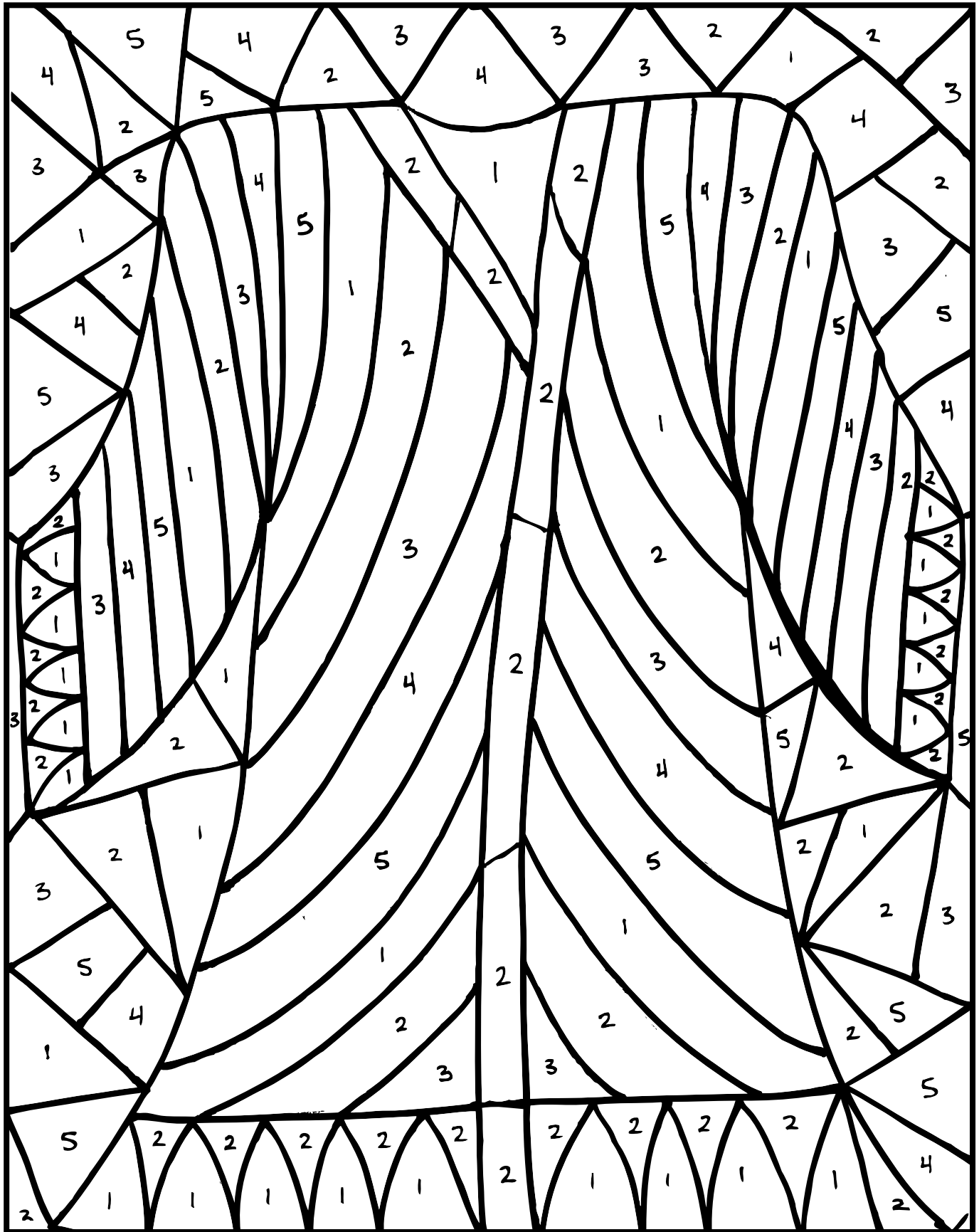


Paint by Number: Joseph's Coat of Many Colors

Paint the following blocks of numbers using 1. Yellow 2. Orange 3. Red 4. Purple 5. Blue



Paper Weaving Craft Teaches Joseph's Lesson

Let's "weave" in the obvious part of the story this week, Joseph's coat, with a deeper lesson the story teaches: that life deals us all kinds of things, both good and bad, yet there can be peace in all of it by making this multicolored paper weaving project.



Supply List

1. T-shirt printout
2. Six colors of construction paper
3. Liquid glue or a glue sticks
4. Markers
5. Scissors

Directions

1. Enlarge this [t-shirt image](#) and print it on card stock quality paper.
2. Draw horizontal lines across each shirt and use a razor blade to slit them open.
3. Cut 1-inch wide strips of six different colors of construction paper.
4. Have the students weave the strips through the shirt, gluing them at the top. (I allowed them to trim the strips at the bottom however they liked.)
5. Write the words from John 16:33 on the woven shirts. "I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart because I have overcome the world." John 16:33
