THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

Communion is a holy meal, we don't take communion just because we're hungry in the middle of the service. It's a meal for the soul, not the body. As we take communion together, we think about how much Jesus loves us and we know this by the sacrifices he made. We remember how to stay close to God and Jesus by praying everyday.

As we take communion together, everyone, no matter what age, is welcome to receive communion at the Lord's Table

OUR SACRED STORY: Communion connects us to the disciples at the Last Supper.

And it connects us to everyone who, like us, have followed Jesus for hundreds and thousands of years. When we take communion, our connection to, or relationship with Jesus and one another is made stronger.

THE LORD'S PRAYER:



Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil; for Thine is the Kingdom, and the Power, and the Glory forever. Amen.



SHARING the MEAL

As we celebrate Communion today, you will first be invited to take the bread and hold it until everyone is served. Once everyone is served the bread we ALL eat the bread at the same time. This act symbolizes that we are ONE BODY and that we are all one in the Spirit of Christ. *Matthew 18:20, "For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them."* New Revised Standard Version.

You will then be invited to take the cup of love which symbolizes the cup of wine that Jesus shared with his friends, saying "This is the cup of love poured out for you." You are invited to prayerfully drink from the cup at your own pace. This demonstrates that we are each individuals in God's Presence - each one doing the best we can to spread God's love.

SCRIPTURE: Luke 24:1-12 1

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. 2 They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, 3 but when they went in, they did not find the body. 4 While they were perplexed about this, suddenly two men in dazzling clothes stood beside them. 5 The women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, but the men said to

them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. 6 Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, 7 that the Son of Man must be handed over to sinners, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again." 8 Then they remembered his words, 9 and returning from the tomb, they told all this to the eleven and to all the rest. 10 Now it was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the other women with them who told this to the apostles. 11 But these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them. 12 But Peter got up and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves; then he went home, amazed at what had happened.

Praise for them springing fresh from the Word



The powers of death have done their worst, but Christ their legions has dispersed;




BENEDICTION: The Pastor often will give a benediction at the end of service. This is like a special prayer asking for God's help, guidance and blessing over everyone before the end of service.




Start at the center of the shape and follow the arrows to fill in the blanks.










