# Bible Story: Ananias helps Saul; Acts 9:10-18 International Children's Bible

<sup>10</sup> There was a follower of Jesus in Damascus named Ananias. The Lord spoke to Ananias in a vision, "Ananias!"

Ananias answered, "Here I am, Lord."
